



Blue Ribbon Window Clings

Window clings are an inexpensive, easy-to-use way to show support for healthy communities and safe children.

Place window clings inside windows to protect them from wind and rain. Clean the window beforehand for clings to stick most effectively. On a store window, display them near eye-level so people quickly take notice.

Here are some ideas on how to use blue ribbon window clings.

Ways to use window clings

- Pass them out to parents with information sheets at a positive parenting event. Window clings look great in the rear window of a car.
- Give to local businesses in recognition of their support, and have them display in their front store windows or on entry doors. A street lined with blue ribbon businesses makes a powerful statement.
- Businesses without store fronts can display clings in their office windows.
- Ask local businesses to help collect donations at their cash registers, and give out window clings in return. Partner the window clings with the donation jars.
- Ask local community groups to exchange clings for donations with residents. Suggest they display them in their front windows to create a blue ribbon neighborhood or block.
- When partnering with or holding events at schools, leave a window cling as a gift for teachers to display in their classrooms—either on the outside window or on a window in the classroom door.
- Display window clings all year round!
